

TANGRAM PROJECT

A tangram is a Chinese puzzle consisting of seven flat shapes, called tans, which initially form a perfect square. The tans are then rearranged to form shapes. The object of the puzzle is to form a specific shape (given only a silhouette) using all seven pieces, which are not allowed to overlap.

If each person is to make his own tangram, then photocopy this page onto colored card stock, one sheet per person. If the tangrams are being provided pre-cut, then photocopy this page and use it as a template for cutting several blank sheets of card stock at a time; one blank sheet per person.

IT IS IMPORTANT TO CUT THE TANS ON THEIR LINES.

Remove and throwaway this grey area - it isn't part of the puzzle.
