

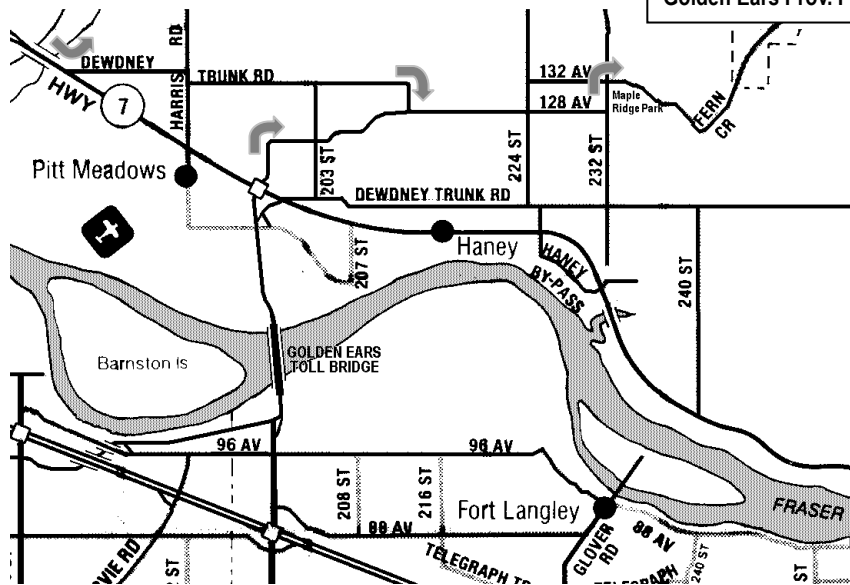
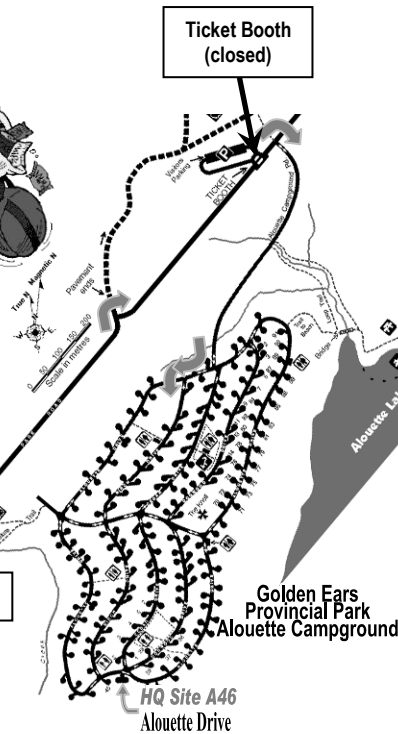
Getting to Tough Guys

Group Equipment List:

Each group is responsible to provide the following items:

Accommodations:

- Tents and/or RV's (no hook-ups)
- Ground sheet for under tent

Food:

- Food and snacks, etc
- Cooking utensils and equipment: pots, pans, cutlery and Coleman stove.

Don't forget plates, matches and fuel!

- Garbage bags, wash basins and water containers
- Lawn chairs, tarps (in case of rain)

Personal Camper's List:

Each person should bring:

- Bible
- Warm jacket
- Running shoes
- Rain gear and boots
- One or two changes of clothes - Shorts
- Pyjamas
- Sleeping bag & Sleeping Pad/Mattress
- Flashlight
- Face cloth, towel, toothbrush, toothpaste and soap
- First-aid supplies & Band-Aids
- Wiener roasting stick
- Mountain Bikes (optional)
- Life Jackets (if available)

All your equipment and belongings should be clearly marked with your identification.

DO NOT BRING:

Walkmans, Ghetto Blasters, Nintendos, Electronic Games, etc

Questions You May Have...

1. Does each boy have to come with his father or a male adult? - No. It is preferred that a boy attend with a man over 18 (eg: family or friend), however, it is not necessary as long as there is a willing adult that he is responsible to (eg: a friend's father or a Brigade leader).
2. Will the participants be insured? - Yes, Brigade does carry insurance for these events.

Please notify the leaders of any physical condition that could affect participation in the weekend's events.

You may pick your own camping spot within your unit's assigned area, but, **We need to average 6-8 people per site.**
