The complete **Sentinel Trails 2 is made up of four Stations**, each with challenging Achievements separated into five sections. A Blockhouse begins with **Exploring God's Word**, which sets a theme through an exciting Bible story, application, and activity. Next comes **Trail Signs** – Bible memory verses that speak God's Truth into the Blockhouse theme. In the middle section are the **Stockade Foundations** that take a closer look at the nuts and bolts of the Stockade and the Stockader's role within it. This is followed by the **Outpost Adventure Page**. The final section is **Others and Me** – one to three activities which help the boy develop personal skills in living with others.

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FOLLOWING JESUS



Mark 1-4



One day, Jesus was walking along the beach at the Sea of Galilee when he saw Simon and Andrew throwing a net into the sea. They were fishermen. Jesus called to them, "Follow Me, and I will make you become fishers of men." Immediately they left their nets and followed Him, becoming His first disciples. Going on a little farther, Jesus saw James and John, the notorious sons of Thunder, who were in their boat mending the nets. Jesus called them, and immediately they left their father and followed Him; becoming His

third and fourth disciples. And so it has been for almost 2,000 years: Jesus calling people to be His disciples, and people choosing to follow Him no matter the cost. He is calling you today.

IN CASE OF FIRE



Stockaders are to be **ALERT** and that means being watchful of what goes on around you. How will you respond when there is trouble?

SELF - The first person you have to look after is yourself. If you are in a dangerous situation, don't panic. Pray! Think out your problem and ensure that you are as safe as possible. As soon as you are safe, then you can help others.

OTHERS - Helping others is a Stockader's priority, but you must realize your own limits. Whenever there is trouble, get assistance – yell for "Help"; get a parent; tell an adult; dial 911; and pray to God. You are not alone. If you can help, then step right in and get busy.

STRUCTURES - Once you and others are safe, then you can look after saving the building, equipment, or land. Remember your limits.



Talk to your Ranger about how you would respond to the following situations:

- 1) You are camping. A strong gust of wind suddenly blows the fire onto a nearby tent and it starts burning. What do you do?
- 2) You are in the church building waiting for a ride when you smell smoke. No one else seems to notice, but you're sure something is burning. You start looking around and discover smoke in a storage closet. What do you do?
